What is Concrete Surface Prep?

Concrete Surface prep is simply the cleaning, grinding or removal of the concrete surface to prepare it for the application of a new surface. This may be for paint, an epoxy coating, waterproof membrane, glues, foam back carpeting, etc.

EDCO Magna Trap Tooling uses three different types of tooling systems to STRIP, GRIND and REMOVE materials from concrete floors.

Strip

Strip Glues and Mastics
from Concrete Floors



The MAGNA BLADE tooling uses a carbide square on the tool piece that “scrapes” stubborn products from the top of the concrete without damaging the concrete. This tool has 8 sides and can be turned 90 degrees and then flipped over for another four sizes.

Glues, mastics, black out, carpet foam, etc. are easily removed without damaging the surface of the concrete.

PRO TIP If the material is “sticky” and can be removed with a putty knife, Magna Blades must be used. By throwing play sand on the top of the concrete this allows the sticky coating to roll up into a ball. This will prevent the glue from overheating and spreading on the floor or “gumming up the tooling.

If the glue is brittle and hard and cannot be removed with a putty knife, Magna
